According to Memorandum of Understanding signed by GSB to drive the National Strategy of Prevention and Suppression of Corruption : Phase 3 (2017-2021) with the Office of the National Counter Corruption Commission, State Enterprise Policy Office and State Enterprises to promote and support of morality and transparency in the operation of state enterprises. GSB declared its policy on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption to comply with the principle of moral assessment and transparency in the operation of Government Sectors. GSB is committed to accomplish the Bank's mission with good governance, anti-corruption, encouraging business operation with transparency and fair manner. GSB Management, Officers and Employees are obliged to do as follows :



Transparency

1

Disclose any information and procurement information with honesty, accuracy, completeness and recency. People and the Bank's stakeholders have easy access to the Bank's information and open to all stakeholders to participate and share opinions to improve the Bank's operation and manage the complaints systematically.

Accountability

2

Perform duties with honesty, integrity, accountability and responsibilities, providing service with fairness, non-discrimination, equality, ready to be responsible for mistakes in decision making and performance.

Corruption-Free

It is a corruption-free policy organization, malpractice by using its position to take benefit for themselves or others, Insist on ethics, morality and core values of the Bank.

Integrity Culture

4

Instill the Bank's core values and culture of anti-corruption, do not tolerate corruption, shame and fear to commit fraud, identify your personal interests and conflict of interests. There are standard to prevent and suppress corruption, including prevention of conflict of interests.

Work Integrity

Work in accordance with the operating procedure, based on accuracy and transparency, focus on human resources development and management systematically, Insist on worthiness, transparency and verifiableness.
